

FREE TAX HELP

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Don't pay a fee to get your refund! The IRS **Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA)** Program provides trained volunteers that will help you file your taxes. This service is available **FOR FREE** to people who earned less than \$55,000 in 2015. E-filing is available, and interpretation services are available at many sites or by appointment.

"You Earned It. Now Claim It!"

- The **Earned Income Credit** is a program for working people, and provides a cash refund if you are eligible.
- **The government could pay you money even if you don't owe any taxes!**

You must bring



- **Proof of identification** (a driver's license or photo ID for you and your spouse)
- **Social Security cards or ITIN letters** (or a SSN or ITIN verification letter issued by the Social Security Administration) for you, spouse, everyone you support
- Copies of all tax returns that you filed in 2015
- Birth dates for you, your spouse, and everyone you support
- All wage and earning statements (Form W-2, W-2G, 1099-MISC), from all employers, in all states
- All 1099 forms (from banks, pensions, casinos, or any other issuer)
- For direct deposit: bank routing and account numbers
- For day care expenses you paid: total paid and the daycare provider's tax ID number (the provider's Social Security Number or provider's business Employer ID number)
- If you are a homeowner: documentation of real estate taxes and mortgage interest paid
- To file taxes electronically on a married filing joint tax return, both spouses must be present to sign the required forms
