

# West High School Academic Policy

- Student academic failures are typically a result of one of the following:
  - Personal or family emergency beyond the control of the student
  - Class schedule that is not appropriate for the student
  - Student lack of effort
- The vast majority of academic failures are due to a lack of student effort. One of our primary academic goals this year is to eliminate student class failures. Students who follow class and school procedures, complete assignments as requested by teachers, and work diligently in their classes will not fail.
- Class failure due to a lack of effort will not be accepted. Failing any class in our high school will result in program changes for the student the following trimester. Juniors and seniors who fail a class will not have open campus privileges. Program changes may include assigning the student to an educational setting located off our main campus.
- There is a well established relationship between student success in high school and being successful as an adult. With the commitment of our students, faculty, and staff, combined with the support of our parents, we are confident we have the necessary resources to achieve this goal for all students.
