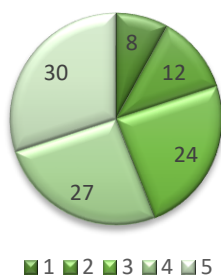
- No World Language graduation requirement

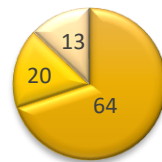

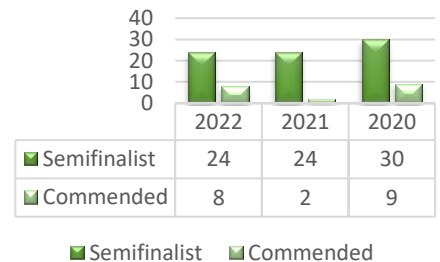
2022 AP Scores

In May 2022, **597** students took **1,042** AP exams in **30** different AP courses. **80%** of the exams received a score of **"3"** or higher.
