<p>Big Idea: People Make a Community Strong</p> <p>Students will be identifying parts of a story, using textual clues to understand characters, comparing and contrasting story elements, as well as working on drawing conclusions.</p>	<p><u>Narrative Writing</u></p> <p>Students will write a personal narrative including vivid words and interesting details. They will focus on sequencing important events using time order words (first, next, then, etc.) as well as reflecting their thoughts and feelings.</p>	<p>Topic 1: Students will be learning how to multiply (joining equal groups) and divide (sharing equally).</p> <p>Topic 2: Using patterns, students will learn to multiply using 0, 1, 2, 5, and 10 as factors.</p>	<p><u>WATER</u></p> <p>Students will experience and explore the properties of water, changes in water, interactions between water and other earth materials, and how humans use water as a natural resource.</p>
