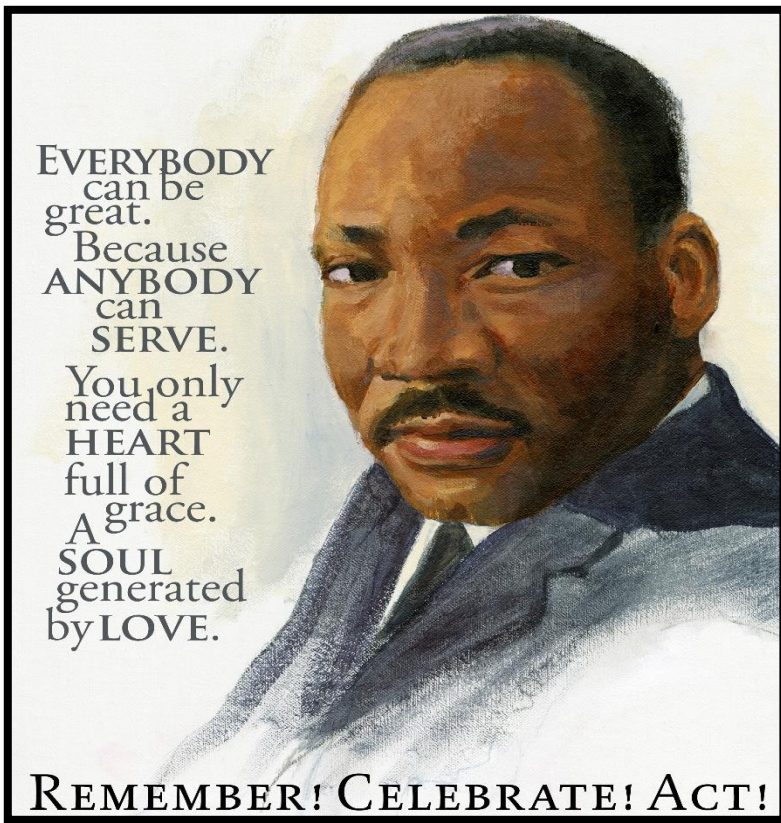


# MLK Focus Day Schedule

### MLK FOCUS DAY

**Embracing Diversity, Encouraging Service,  
Enhancing Cultural Inclusiveness**

Martin Luther King, Jr. Day offers a unique opportunity to connect students directly with ICCSD missions of cultural inclusion and acceptance of diversity. The goal of this day is to incorporate conversations on diversity and civil rights with service-learning activities in order to teach cultural understanding and inclusion. We hope to commemorate as well the timeless values Martin Luther King, Jr. taught us through his life — the values of courage, truth, justice, compassion, and service.

#### Service Fair

A variety of community service organizations will have stations to provide information about volunteer opportunities for all students.

**Organizations participating in the Service Fair:** *United Way, Iowa Children's Museum, Table to Table, 4C- Community Coordinated Child Care, AmeriCorps, Shelter House, Johnson County Crisis Center, Habitat for Humanity, Iowa City Animal Center, North Liberty Community Library, North Liberty Recreation Center, North Liberty Community Pantry, North Liberty Community Garden*

**1st period (8:50-9:25):** All students will report to their 1st period class. All classes will watch two short videos, confirm their schedule for the day and engage in conversations about the events of the day. Attendance will be taken.

**2nd period (9:35-10:45)- Guest Speaker:** All students will go with their 1<sup>st</sup> period class and teacher to the Auditorium for the guest speaker presentation. Students will have assigned seating in the Auditorium with their teacher.

**3rd period (10:50-11:40)- Diversity Talks:** All students will report to their 3rd period class. During this hour, all students will engage in meaningful conversations and/or activities about diversity, identity, inclusion, and service. Teachers will select a Diversity Speaker session to attend **OR** lead an interactive discussion or activity with students in their classroom. Attendance will be taken by the teacher.

**4th period (11:40-1:11):** All students will go to their regular 4th period class. Attendance will be taken. Lunch will be based on the regular schedule for the class period. Teachers and students will attend the **Service Fair in the Main Gym** to learn about great volunteer opportunities in our community according to the schedule below. While in class, students will check afternoon schedules and view or discuss relevant content to the themes of MLK Day.

**A Lunch Service Fair:** 12:55 - 1:05 (end of period)

**B Lunch Service Fair:** 11:55 - 12:09 (then lunch)

**C Lunch Service Fair:** 12:25 - 12:39 (then lunch)

**5th period (1:15-2:15):** All students will go to their 1st selected session of the day. Attendance will be taken at the session by the teacher present.

**6th period (2:20-3:20):** All students will go to their 2<sup>nd</sup> selected session of the day. Attendance will be taken at the session by the teacher present.

**7th period (3:25 - 4:00):** All students will go to their 7th period class. Attendance will be taken. Students will use the class period to complete a short survey and debrief about the day.
