Dual enrollment is enrollment with a public school district of a child who is receiving Competent Private Instruction (CPI) usually for the purpose of attending one or more courses or extracurricular activities offered by the district. **Iowa Code section 299A.8; 281 IAC r. 31.6** Students may dual enroll and also participate in the ICHSAP as follows: **Declaratory Ruling #44, 5 D.o.E. App. Dec. 33**, states that a parent, guardian, or legal or actual custodian may not use dual enrollment to enroll a child in all courses but one (e.g. a child could take 5 of 7 classes via dual enrollment). The Senior Year Plus (SYP) program provides that a student may not enroll on a full-time basis in a post-secondary institution under *SYP. 261E7 (2)*
