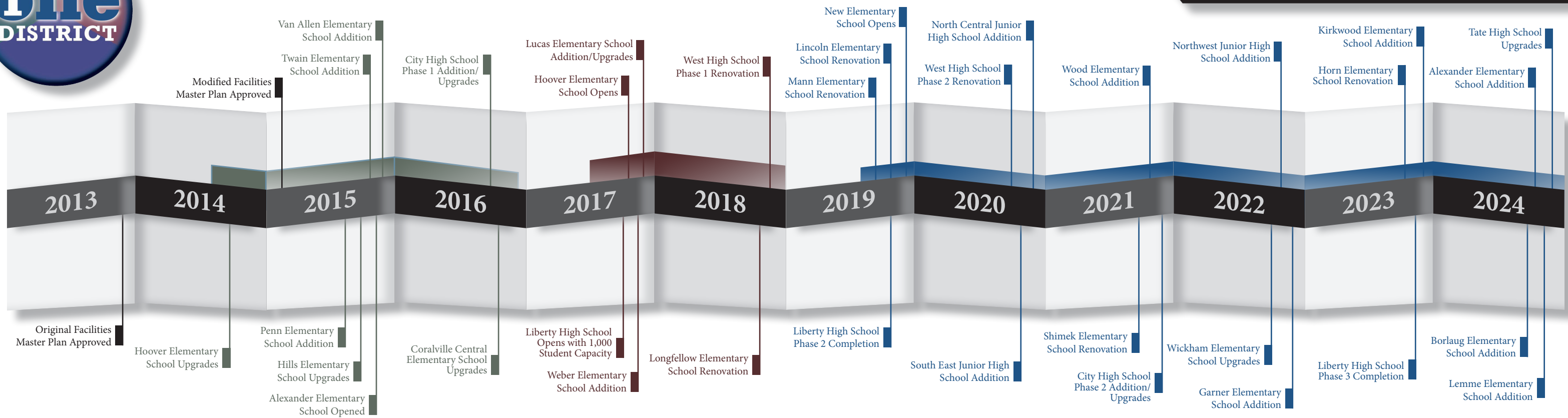

COMPLETED PROJECTS

BACKGROUND

On December 10, 2013, the original Iowa City Community School District Facilities Master Plan (FMP) was approved by the Board of Education following a year-long development process led by the FMP Steering Committee. The committee engaged the community in the process including seven public input meetings and six committee meetings. Over 500 community members participated in the planning process. The FMP Steering Committee enlisted the assistance of BLDD Architects to provide an analysis of the District's current buildings, identify facility needs and make recommendations to the committee.

On April 14, 2015, the Board of Education approved an update to the District's 10-year FMP and extended the plan to 2025.

- Hoover Elementary School:** Building code repairs and air conditioning.
- Van Allen Elementary School:** Classroom addition (+100) and geothermal system upgrades.
- Twain Elementary School:** Addition includes gymnasium, music & art rooms, restrooms, office, and storage space. Renovations include accessibility renovations, geothermal heat pump HVAC system, and window wall replacement.
- Penn Elementary School:** Classroom addition (+200), MPR addition, geothermal HVAC system upgrade, carpet replacement, and IT updates.
- Hills Elementary School:** Building code repairs.
- Alexander Elementary School:** New 500 student elementary.
- City High School:** Six classroom third floor addition (+150).
- Coralville Central Elementary School:** Classroom renovations, accessibility renovations, masonry tuckpointing, geothermal HVAC system upgrade.

PROJECTS IN PROGRESS/FUTURE PROJECTS W/ SECURED FUNDING

- Lucas Elementary School:** Interior lighting upgrades, geothermal heat pump HVAC system, ceiling replacement, window wall replacement.
- Hoover Elementary School:** New 500 student elementary. Utilized as transitional building first two years to house Longfellow, Lincoln and Mann students during their building renovations.
- Liberty High School (Phase 1):** 1,000 student core facility opens for new 1,500 student high school.
- Weber Elementary School:** Classroom addition (+200), gymnasium addition and interior lighting upgrades.
- West High School (Phase 1):** New tennis courts, new mechanical infrastructure, new practice gymnasium, renovated cafeteria, renovated kitchen and loading dock, relocated and improved cardiovascular workout room.
- Longfellow Elementary School:** Historical renovation of building and gymnasium addition.

FUTURE PROJECTS SUBJECT TO BOND APPROVAL

- New North Liberty Elementary School:** New 600 student elementary and preschool.
- Lincoln Elementary School:** Gymnasium addition, accessibility renovations, roof replacement, HVAC system, window replacement. Music and art room additions.
- Mann Elementary School:** Historical renovation of building, gymnasium addition and improved accessibility.
- Liberty High School (Phase 2):** Outdoor athletics facilities.
- North Central Junior High School:** Classroom addition (+250), library and cafeteria expansions. Athletic improvements including second gymnasium.
- South East Junior High School:** Classroom addition (+50), accessibility renovations, HVAC system renovations, interior lighting upgrades, locker replacement, and roof replacement. Athletic improvements including track & field practice venues. New kitchen and increased cafeteria area and office space.
- West High School (Phase 2):** Geothermal HVAC heating and cooling system installation, interior & exterior renovations, new windows, roofing, electrical and plumbing upgrades.
- Wood Elementary School:** Music and art room additions, HVAC system and roof replacement.
- Shimek Elementary School:** Gymnasium addition, roof replacement and geothermal heat pump HVAC system. Classroom renovations including art and music.
- City High School:** Classroom addition, cafeteria and kitchen expansion. Renovations include accessibility improvements, geothermal heat pump system, and roof replacement. Athletic improvements including wrestling room addition, additional gym space, lighting renovations.
- Northwest Junior High School:** Classroom addition (+50), roof replacement, interior lighting upgrades and HVAC system. Athletic improvements including track & field practice venues.
- Wickham Elementary School:** Music and art room additions. Gymnasium floor repairs.
- Garner Elementary School:** Music and art room additions, playground and sod replacement, structural wall and floor repairs.
- Kirkwood Elementary School:** Classroom addition (+50), updated HVAC system and roof replacement. Music and art room additions.
- Horn Elementary School:** Improved accessibility. Interior lighting upgrades, classroom door replacement, and exterior improvements.
- Liberty High School (Phase 3):** 500 student addition.
- Tate High School:** Classroom addition (+50) and gymnasium addition. Exterior lighting, ceiling repairs, mechanical upgrades.
- Alexander Elementary School:** Classroom addition (+100).
- Borlaug Elementary School:** Music and art room additions. Minor repairs.
- Lemme Elementary School:** Music and art room additions, gymnasium addition, window replacement and HVAC upgrades.
