BUILDING OVERVIEW:

Built in 1939 as a joint project between the Iowa City Community School District and the Public Works Administration, City High school has served the students of Iowa City since 1939. The main campus building is an imposing landmark situated on a hill overlooking the east side residential area of Iowa City. It has become a landmark and a source of pride for the community. Numerous additions to the building have occurred since 1939, including a 15 classroom addition in 2005. In 2013, a brand new, state of the art performing arts wing was built. This \$6.2 million addition included new rehearsal spaces for Band, Orchestra, and Vocal Music.
