

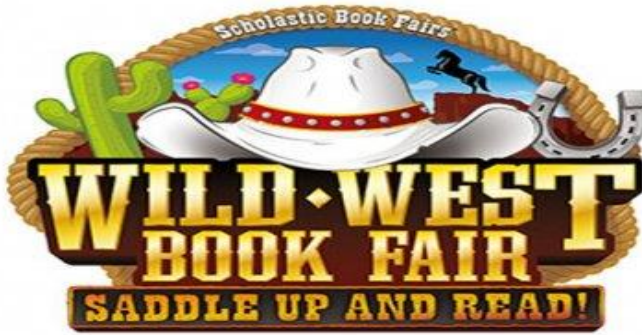

## **Student Drop Off & Pick Up**

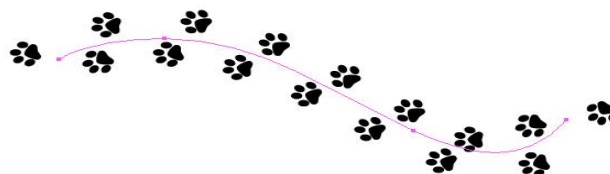
For the continued safety of our students and staff, we ask that you please adhere to our Drop Off & Pick Up Procedures:

If you are picking up your student by vehicle, please do so by utilizing the Car Line located at the parking entrance/exit on the east side of the building.

If you choose to park your vehicle and wait for your student(s) to enter/exit the building, please do so in a **legal, designated parking area**. **DO NOT** park in the Bus Loading Zone, double park, park blocking parking lot exits or park across sidewalks. These actions pose a serious threat to the safety of our students both on foot and in/on other modes of transportation.

Respect our Safety Patrol Officers by following traffic rules and guidelines, watching your speed, as well as complying with posted and hand held Stop signs.

### **PARENT VOLUNTEER INFORMATION**

Are you interested in volunteering as a teacher's helper or field trip chaperone? We appreciate your willingness to donate your time, and ask that prior to your initial volunteering opportunity, that you complete a Volunteer Application, which includes a Criminal Records check and Child Abuse check. Please allow two weeks for your application to be processed. Once your application has been approved you may contact your child's teacher, the main office or the PTO to inquire about available volunteer opportunities.

Any persons without an approved Volunteer Application on file with the district, will not be allowed to volunteer in classrooms or chaperone/attend field trips.
