NESTS

(Nurturing Every Student Together Safely)

Coralville has worked with community partners to bring support services to families while the Iowa City Community School District is using the hybrid and online school models.

- These services range from once a week programs aimed at social and emotional well-being for children and families, to all day programs that support children in an all-day school with wrap around before and after school age care services. The programs help families when school is not fully in session at school locations by extending a helping hand to **Nurture Every Student Together Safely (NESTS)**.

The programs may focus on any or several of the following:

- Respite site to help with isolation stress
- Adult supervision or assistance with academic learning
- Homework help
- Enrichment activities
- Access to community resources for other services
- School age care
