

Data related to questions received about Hills Elementary School

Questions were received regarding how far out from Hills Elementary the boundary would have to go in order to reach 400 students and how much busing would cost. Two methods were used to estimate these areas, one using circles and one using horizontal lines. Busing costs approximately \$40,000 per route (2012-13 pricing). A standard bus holds 71 passengers (3 to a seat).
