

## How to Interpret Iowa's Accounting Code Structure

On July 1, 1994, the Iowa City Community School District began using the 20 digit account numbers for coding its expenditures. This change was mandated by the Department of Education. The breakdown of the account dimensions are as follows:

This account structure was further modified on July 1, 2004 to reflect consistency with federal reporting standards for schools.

**Fund** is a fiscal and accounting entity. The funds used in the Iowa City Community School District are: General(10), Nutrition(61), Athletic/Activity(21), Management(22), Flexible Benefits Trust(72), Self-Insured Health Trust(71), Capital Projects(33), Capital Projects-SAVE/SILO (33), Debt Service(40), and PPEL(36).

**Facility/Building** is a breakdown of our accounts by building, district wide or level of instruction. Our facility numbers are all 4 digits. All elementary schools begin with 19. The junior high schools begin with 31 and the senior high schools begin with 32.

**Function** describes the activity for which a service or object is acquired. Functions are classified into five broad areas: Instruction, support services, operation of non-instructional services, facilities acquisition/construction services and other outlays. We will use the function code which uses 4 digits to provide a reasonable level of detail.

**Program** is a three digit code that will allow the district to classify expenditures by a specific area such as art, music, math, science, etc. The State has defined 9 broad program areas

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which are regular education, special education, vocational education, other instructional, non-public school, adult/continuing education, community/junior college education, community service and enterprise.

**Project** is the four digit code that will be used to classify expenditures that are supported by special funding. This code will be used to track expenditures related to such programs as Title 1, Title II, Phase III, Family Resource Programs, other categorical funding and the various sports. Many expenditures will not use this dimension and will appear as '0000'.

**Object** is the last dimension of the account number and is three digits. This dimension is used to define the specific service or product obtained by the district. The object will describe the expenditure as salary (100), employee benefits (200), purchased professional and technical services (300), purchased property services (400), transportation and tuition (500), supplies (600), equipment and property (700) and other (800). Note: The object codes between 100 and 299 are payroll related and should never be used for purchases on a requisition.

**Key:**

Accounting codes are provided to each Iowa district by the Iowa Department of Education. Their goal is uniformity of reporting across the state. As a result, ICCSD has little local discretion when accounting for cost centers within the operations of the district.

**How to read a General Ledger Account Code:**

A typical account code has 20 digits and is broken into 6 sections = xx-xxxx-xxxx-xxx-xxxx-xxx.

xx= Fund; xxxx = building location; xxxx = function area; xxx = program area; xxxx = project area; xxx = object area

Example: 10-3118-1100-102-0000-121

10 = general fund; 3118 = Southeast Junior High; 1100 = regular classroom instruction; 102 = Art program; 0000 = unused; 121 = teacher salary
