ATTENDANCE AREA DEVELOPMENT: SPRING 2014



The Iowa City Community School District is conducting a community engagement process to gain input from the community related to school attendance areas. While the full review of attendance areas within the District is a multi-year process, three attendance areas will be reviewed this spring. The District is committed to having the school community involved in this process. This community engagement is a critical component to help inform the Superintendent prior to making his recommendation to the Board of Education regarding school attendance areas.

The Spring 2014 Attendance Area Development (AAD) engagement process will include a District-wide kick off meeting, and then a series of meetings regarding each specific attendance area cluster. The Superintendent plans to make a recommendation to the Board of Education on, or before, May 13, 2014, regarding elementary clusters 1 and 2 and the secondary cluster. While the first phase of the engagement process and the recommendation to the Board will be completed in spring 2014, changes to attendance areas will not take effect until the beginning of the 2015 – 2016 school year for these clusters.

District attendance area clusters for Spring 2014:

Cluster 1: Coralville Central, Garner, Kirkwood, Lincoln, Penn, Van Allen, Wickham

Cluster 2: Hills, Lemme, Longfellow, Twain, Weber, Wood and the new South Elementary

Secondary Cluster: City, West, Northwest, South East, North Central and the new North High School

Information and schedules for the remaining elementary clusters will be released closer to the beginning of the AAD process for each cluster.
